TO: District Superintendents

Attached is the 2009 list of Academically Unacceptable Schools (AUS) and schools in School Improvement 1 and 2 that will be released to the press later today. Your district will receive a memorandum from Superintendent Pastorek outlining the specific requirements for each school on the list.

The list being released by the Department today does not include alternative schools. In February, the Board of Elementary and Secondary (BESE) adopted the recommendation of the Accountability Commission to calculate scores for alternative schools and not allow districts to route scores to students' home schools. However, last week BESE voted to delay the release of School Performance Scores for alternative schools until the Board could consider recommendations from the School and District Accountability Commission in regard to changing the evaluation method of alternative schools.

We apologize for the delay in this year's Preliminary SPS release.
